Information About Volunteering and Chaperoning Field Trips (updated information)

If you are interested in chaperoning, please complete these checks as soon as possible!

For school purposes, checks are valid for a maximum of three years and must be repeated and resubmitted once expired if the individual wishes to remain a registered volunteer with the school.
